85 Attendance by Police

One police representative attended the meeting.

Twenty four crimes had been committed in within Christchurch Ward since the last meeting. These included a burglary, several thefts, a public order offence, an assault on a licensed premises, a robbery, three section 27 banning orders and 9 incidents of anti-social behaviour. Several arrests had been made.

The statistics in All Saints were slightly better. Crimes included possession of a class A drug with intent to supply, a cannabis warning, criminal damage and 11 incidents of anti-social behaviour.

The shop watch scheme now had good coverage in Town.

89a Allerdale Local Plan (Part One) Submission to the Secretary of State for Public Examination

Allerdale Borough Council has submitted the Allerdale Local Plan (part one) to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government on 23 October 2013 for independent examination.

Agreed – That the submission of the Allerdale Local Plan (Part One) to the Secretary

of State be noted.

89b Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Resolved – (a) That due to location and accessibility issues at Grassmoor Sports Centre an alternative polling station be investigated.

(b) That Highfield Community Centre be considered as an alternative polling station to All Saints School.

89c Cumbria County Council – Budget Consultation

Cumbria County Council has seen its funding reduced significantly and has already delivered saving of £88 million (2011/12 to 2013/14). Reductions in Government funding mean further savings of almost £80 million over the next 3 years (2014/15 to 2016/17).

The main purpose of this consultation was to ask for comments/feedback on proposals to deliver £24.415 million in savings between 1 April 2014 and 31 March 2015.

Resolved – (a) That a strong object to proposition 29, the introduction of targeted on-street parking charges be sent to Cumbria County Council due to the negative economic effect this would have on trade in the Town. Cumbria County Council to be encouraged to review how street management is administered instead.

(b) That a strong objection to proposition 24, cease to subsidise bus services and instead work with communities to find community transport solutions be sent to Cumbria County Council due to the effect this would have on our town.

89d Notification of Bus Service Withdrawal

The County Council has been advised by Reays Coaches that they are withdrawing services, 34, 35. 36 & 57m with effect from 9th December 2013. These services are not subsidised by Cumbria County Council and this decision made by Reays Coaches has been made on an entirely commercial basis. Cumbria County Council was considering the implications of these service withdrawals.

Councillor Nicholson informed those present that this service was being re-tendered and that two operators were interested in taking over the service although the times may be tweaked.

Agreed – That the withdrawal of services 34, 35, 36 & 57m by Reays Coaches be noted.

89e Consultation of the site selection process for a Geological Disposal Facility

The current consultation is about revising the siting process prior to the Government considering expressions of interest again from local bodies for an area

to host a geological disposal facility – MRWS 2. Under MRWS 2, local bodies in Cumbria would have the same right to put forward areas for consideration as other parts of England and Wales.

To assist Local Councils, CALC's Executive Committee has considered the issues and agreed a draft consultation paper. CALC are encouraging us to submit our own response and let CALC have any views on its proposed response.

The deadline date for comments is 5 December 2013.

Resolved – That Cockermouth Town Council supports CALC's response.
